466 - Liverpool



Letter from Ceara, May 16, 1888 to Paris, carried by the British ship "Parana" of the "Royal Mail Steamship C^o". 1000 Réis UPU fifth rate. On arrival at Liverpool on June 2, the uncanceled Brazilian stamps received the local mark "466" between bars. Forwarded to France, the correspondence entered by Calais on June 4, and was received in Paris the same day.
